



The ATV Safety Rules:



GET FAMILIAR WITH ATV SAFETY

ATVs are not toys. Serious injury can result from improper use of ATVs, but with preparation and practice, you can safely develop and expand your riding skills. Riding ATVs can be an enjoyable form of outdoor recreation when done properly. ATVs can also be used for agricultural or utility use.

Remember that riders under 16 years of age must be supervised by an adult. If you have a child who is about ready to ride an ATV, there are special considerations that you should keep in mind. Although a child may be the recommended age to ride a particular size ATV, not all children have the strength, skills, or judgment needed to operate an ATV. You should supervise your child's operation of the ATV at all times, and should permit continued use only if you determine that your child has the ability and judgment to operate the ATV safely.
